WELCOME to Vacaville Optometric Vision Center. Established in 1954, Vacaville Optometric Vision Center has been providing the highest quality eye care to Vacaville and the surrounding areas for over 45 years. We look forward to caring for you and your family's eye care needs.

APPOINTMENTS: Patients are seen by appointment Monday through Friday. Our receptionist is available daily until 5:00 P.M. to assist you.

CANCELLATIONS: When you schedule an appointment, we reserve the doctor's time for you and make every effort to be on time. If you are unable to keep your appointment, please call 24 hours ahead so there will be time to schedule another patient in your examination period.

VISION INSURANCE: Many of our patients have vision coverage as part of their insurance plan. It is important to remember that your vision insurance is an agreement between you and your insurance company. We will be glad to assist you in preparing and submitting the required forms for your vision benefits.

We are panel doctors for Vision Service Plan (VSP), Medicare, MES, and Tricare.

COST OF CARE: Do you hesitate to ask about our fees and what they include? To keep down the cost of your eye care, we encourage you to pay for services at the time of your office visit. For your convenience we accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express.

THE EYE EXAMINATION: Vacaville Optometric Vision Center has remained state-of-the-art with the use of computerized instruments. Your eye examination will begin with an initial case history. This is intended to reveal whether your problem, if you have one, is the result of an eye problem or your general health. Diabetes, allergies, high blood pressure, and circulation problems, are just a few of the general diseases that can affect the eye and change your vision. Knowing your occupational and recreational visual requirements will assist us in determining the lenses that will be best suited for your individual needs.

Next, the doctor will carefully measure your refractive error and determine if you will need a correction to help you see better and more comfortably. Then the doctor will thoroughly inspect the external and internal parts of your eyes for signs of eye or systemic diseases.

Occasionally, consultation with other specialists about additional care for you is needed. If this occurs, we will recommend other specialists who may help with your health or vision problems. Your well-being is our primary concern.

EYEGASSES: Eyeglasses are intended to help you see better and more comfortably. All of our prescribed lenses meet or exceed the standards set by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration and OSHA. Our first priority in providing eyewear is giving careful attention to each patient's individual needs – not trying to make their eyeglasses in an hour. Our expert staff treats every patient as a unique individual, not as a “mass consumer.” We believe that this is the kind of personal attention our patients want and deserve. We promise more than one hour of work will go into making your new glasses.

CONTACT LENSES: Millions of people choose contact lenses as an alternative to eyeglasses. Vacaville Optometric Vision Center provides complete professional care for all of your contact lens needs. From the initial contact lens evaluation to follow-up care and yearly examinations, we ensure that contact lens wear is still right for you. Many vision conditions, including nearsightedness, farsightedness, and astigmatism, are correctable with contact lenses. If you have never tried contact lenses, we can determine if you are a good candidate and recommend the proper lenses for you.

REFRACTIVE SURGERY: In the past, glasses or contact lenses provided the traditional sources of correction for imperfect vision. The desire to be free of glasses or contact lenses has inspired ophthalmic surgeons to develop surgical alternatives for refractive correction. One alternative is Laser Vision Correction. This procedure utilizes the excimer laser, a cool ultra violet light, to correct refractive disorders. Eyesight problems are unique to each individual. Drs. Carney and Carr work with experienced surgeons to thoroughly examine your eyes and discuss the appropriate options available for your specific needs.
